

HOW DOES HOMEBOUND VOTING WORK?

Once your application for homebound voting has been reviewed and accepted, an election official will contact you and arrange for a mutually convenient time to visit your home so you and your caregiver, if eligible, can both vote in the by-election.

WHEN DOES HOMEBOUND VOTING TAKE PLACE?

Homebound voting is available during the same days and times as advance voting.

WHAT IF HOMEBOUND VOTING IS NOT AVAILABLE?

If you will not be available in your home during the homebound voting period, you may still vote by absentee ballot. Additional information and absentee ballot applications are available online at www.elections.sk.ca/homebound.

Elections Saskatchewan is committed to providing full accessibility to all eligible voters.

This includes offering several flexible voting options, including absentee voting, advanced voting, and homebound voting.



WHAT IS HOMEBOUND VOTING?

Homebound voting is available to eligible voters who cannot vote at an advanced poll or at a regular poll due to a disability (including immobility, illness, or infirmity). In addition to the eligible voter with a disability, caregivers for the eligible voters may also qualify for homebound voting at the same time. Caregivers may include a family member or home care worker.

HOW TO APPLY FOR HOMEBOUND VOTING

If you are homebound due to a disability, you can apply for homebound voting to the constituency returning office. This application can be found online at www.elections.sk.ca/homebound or by calling Elections Saskatchewan at 1.877.958.8683. Completed applications can be emailed or dropped off in person to the constituency returning office. If you are not able to send in your application due to your disability, please call 1.877.958.8683 and Elections Saskatchewan will make arrangements for you. Do not ask a third party to send it in on your behalf.
