**Note:** Where any person whose name is recorded in the Register of the Chief Electoral Officer ceases to act as Auditor of a registered political party, the leader of the party shall forthwith appoint a new Auditor (this form) and by instrument in writing signed by him or her (Form E-519) notify the Chief Electoral Officer of the alteration pursuant to section 226 of *The Election Act, 1996*. Upon receipt of any such notice the Chief Electoral Officer shall vary the register accordingly (s. 226(4)).
